


## **Local Notices to Mariners**

LNTM No.	011/2022
Subject	IALA Port Traffic Signals

From **Monday 2 May 2022** entry and exit into St Peter Port will be controlled by IALA "traffic lights". These are internationally recognised signals that give the VTS Officer more flexibility over harbour movements.

The lights will apply to all vessels entering or leaving St Peter Port Harbour.

In **St Sampson Harbour** the display of three vertical red lights (No 2) will indicate that a large commercial vessel is entering or leaving St Sampson with a Pilot embarked. All other vessels shall not proceed until the lights are extinguished. Failure to comply with these signals is an offence under Section 1 of the Harbours Ordinance, 1988.



No I: (Flashing) Serious Emergency

- all vessels to stop or divert according to instructions

No 2: Vessels shall not proceed

No 3: Vessels may proceed. One way traffic

No 4: Vessels may proceed. Two way traffic

No 5: Vessels may proceed only when it has received specific orders to do so
